Footnotes

SPEARGUN between foes early, prompted the pace outside a rival, took the lead and inched away on the turn, angled in leaving the bend and drew off in the stretch under urging. SIR NEWCASTLE stalked inside, split horses on the turn, continued a bit off the rail into the stretch and just held second. AWKWARD MONDAYS between rivals early, chased off the rail, angled in some on the turn, came out in the stretch and just missed the place. DEL MAR

JOHNNY broke out a bit, stalked between horses, went three deep midway on the turn, continued outside into the stretch and weakened. THIRTEEN BLACK squeezed back at the start, settled outside, went four wide into the stretch and improved position. DANGER LURKING broke in a bit, pulled between foes then stalked off the rail, angled in on the turn, came out leaving the bend and into the stretch and lacked a further response. QUICK CENIZAS squeezed back at the start, settled off the rail, angled in on the backstretch, came out some into the stretch and was not a threat. BIG MAN IN BLACK went up four wide to stalk the pace, continued outside on the turn and four wide again into the stretch and weakened. STORMIN ARVIN had good early speed off the rail, angled in and stalked between foes, dropped back outside a rival on the turn and also weakened. TULLOS between foes early, settled outside a rival then off the rail, angled in on the turn and failed to menace. WARREN'S CLOSER angled in and saved ground off the pace, continued inside on the turn and did not rally. WARREN'S COLE came out early, chased outside, went five wide into the stretch and was not a factor. ROTHSTEIN went up inside to duel for the lead, stalked on the turn, dropped back into and through the stretch and gave way.
