Footnotes

INDY POINT (ARG) pulled his way along inside then stalked a bit off the rail, went outside a rival leaving the second turn and four wide into the stretch, rallied under some urging to gain the lead three deep a sixteenth out and proved best. VAGABOND SHOES (IRE) settled outside a rival then just off the rail on the backstretch, came out on the second turn and four wide into the stretch and gained the place late. LUCAYAN (FR) unhurried and angled in outside a rival early, found the inside on the second turn, rallied along the rail in the stretch then came out in deep stretch and just got the show. OLD TIME HOCKEY three deep early, chased outside a rival, came out three wide into the stretch and finished willingly between foes late. TEAKS NORTH pulled his way along to duel inside then stalked a bit off the rail, bid again outside a foe on the second turn and into the stretch, took a short lead in the drive, was between foes past midstretch and was outfinished. SLIM SHADEY (GB) a bit wide on the hill, angled in and duelled outside a rival then inched away and angled in, set the pace inside, fought back on the second turn and until past midstretch and weakened late. KETTLE CORN settled inside then a bit off the rail, came out into the stretch and lacked the needed rally. HOLDING GLORY (BRZ) pulled along the inside then saved ground chasing the pace, came out into the stretch and could not offer the necessary response. IRISH SURF three deep on the hill, chased outside a rival, came out leaving the second turn and into the stretch

and lacked the needed rally. TALE OF A CHAMPION pulled between horses leaving the hill then stalked inside, continued along the rail on the second turn and weakened. CODE OF CONDUCT had a shoe fixed delaying the start, settled off the rail then three deep into the first turn, stalked outside a rival or off the inside, came out into the stretch and weakened. AFFRETTANDO hopped slightly at the start, settled outside a rival then saved ground off the pace to the stretch to no avail.
