AMERICAN SYSTEM stalked the pace off the rail, bid outside the leader and took a short advantage into the stretch and inched clear late under urging. REQUESTO sped to the early lead, set the pace inside, fought back when headed, brushed the rail past midstretch and held second. BRINGEM JUNG stalked the leaders along the inside, came off the rail on the turn, could make no impact on the top pair in the lane but clearly bested the others. DANTHEBLUEGRASSMAN broke slowly, settled off the rail, moved up outside on the turn, came out some into the stretch and lacked the needed response. FLYING SOLDIER chased outside on the backstretch, angled to the rail for the turn and weakened. FEBRUARY STORM settled just off the inside, also angled to the rail on the turn and gave way.
