Footnotes

ROYAL F J settled a bit off the rail, went around a rival on the hill, cut the corner into the stretch, bid inside to gain the lead, inched away under urging a sixteenth out and proved best. MY SUMMER SLEW lunged a bit at the start, stalked three deep, came four wide into the stretch and continued willingly. RED JAG saved ground chasing the pace, came out into the stretch, bid between foes in midstretch and outfinished a rival for the show. OFF THE WALL

sped to the early lead, set the pace a bit off the rail then inside leaving the hill, fought back between foes in midstretch and lost third. POSSE POWER chased between horses then angled in leaving the hill, went around a rival into the stretch and was outfinished. CHEROKEE HEAVEN chased off the rail, went three deep leaving the hill, swung five wide into the stretch and could not offer the necessary late kick. EL VINO dropped back outside then cut the corner at the right hand curve, angled in and settled a bit off the rail and improved position some in the stretch. SHEDIAK (FR) squeezed a bit at the start, settled off the inside, swung five wide into the stretch and lacked a rally. MOMENT OF WEAKNESS (IRE) chased between foes then inside on the hill and into the stretch and weakened. CONSULADO stalked three deep then outside a rival leaving the hill and weakened in the stretch. SOUTHERN STYLE chased outside then three deep, came four wide into the stretch and did not rally. HALF DOME DUDE had good early speed and stalked between horses, steadied sharply between foes on the hill, came three deep into the stretch and weakened. Rail on hill at zero.
