Footnotes

PRIME TIMBER, broke a bit slowly, stalked the pace three deep and rallied determinedly under left handed urging to prove best. FIRST TITANIUM sped to the early lead and angled in, set the pace inside, fought back in the stretch but could not match the winner late and just held second. SPICE GUY pulled his way along to stalk the early pace, bid outside FIRST TITANIUM on the backstretch and continued willingly through the stretch. HEROIC BLUE, off a bit slowly, saved ground, came out on the second turn and into the stretch with a late bid. IMPRESSIVE GRADES, chased close up between horses, was shuffled back a bit into the second turn, waited when boxed in entering the stretch, tried to get out in midstretch but could not offer the necessary late response. AUDMAR saved ground stalking the pace, waited briefly leaving the second turn and weakened some late.
