Footnotes

FRESAL stalked off the rail then moved between horses leaving the backstretch and again on the turn, collared the pacesetter under urging in deep stretch and proved best. SUNNY OUTCOME had speed between horses then angled in and dueled inside, inched away into the stretch but could not hold off the winner. JAZZ YA chased three deep on the backstretch, split horses into the turn, found the rail on the bend and bested the others. LOVER JONES sent inside to press the pace, stalked on the backstretch, dropped back and came out on the turn and lacked a further response. AMIABLE AMY dueled between horses then outside the runner-up, fell back into the stretch and weakened. MISS CARRERA prompted the early pace four wide then stalked three deep on the backstretch and turn and also weakened. DOCKET unhurried between horses then outside a rival to the stretch and failed to menace. C R CHARM saved ground off the pace, continued inside on the turn and into the stretch and was not a factor.
