SILENTIO angled in and stalked inside, slipped through along the rail into the stretch, gained the lead, inched away under urging in midstretch and held gamely. BATTLE FORCE broke a bit slowly, settled inside then just off the rail, swung six wide into the stretch and finished well. MENTAL GIANT prompted the pace outside a rival, battled back and was floated out a bit into the stretch and held third. OUR BOY BENJAMIN chased outside a rival, fell back some on the second turn, came three deep into the stretch, steadied briefly off heels in midstretch, came out again and was edged for the show. HY POINT PLAYER a step slow to begin, angled in and chased just off the rail, was between horses into the stretch and lacked the needed late kick. MAY WEATHER stalked off the rail or outside a rival, was three deep leaving the second turn, came out some into the stretch and could not offer the necessary response. PETAK MOUNTAIN saved ground chasing the pace throughout and lacked the needed rally. HAVA CIGAR angled in and chased outside a rival, went three deep on the second turn, swung five wide into the stretch and could not summon the needed response in the stretch. BIG BAD BARRY bobbled slightly at the start, was sent inside early, set a pressured pace along the rail, came out into the stretch and weakened.
