Footnotes

HOT RIDE had speed between horses then duelled outside the runner-up, battled under urging in the stretch, bumped with that one in midstretch and again a sixteenth out, inched away late and prevailed. FOREST SOUVENIR had good early speed and set a pressured pace a bit off the rail, fought back when bumped in midstretch, came out slightly to bump the winner under left handed pressure a sixteenth out and could not match that one late. ENDLESS CRUISE a step slow into stride, saved ground stalking the pace throughout, lacked a rally in the stretch and bested the others. WARREN'S CLYDE broke a bit slowly, settled just off the rail, angled in on the turn and was not a threat. NEBIKON between horses early, chased outside a rival to the stretch and weakened. RINO U three deep early, settled off the rail, came three wide into the stretch and lacked a further response. MUDVILLE NINE had speed outside the top pair early then broke down midway on the backstretch. A claim of foul by the rider of the runner-up against the winner for alleged interference in the stretch was not allowed by the stewards, who ruled both runners contributed to the contact between them.
