Footnotes

VRONSKY had speed outside a rival early, angled in on the backstretch, dueled inside, inched away in the stretch and proved best under urging. PRIME TIME EVENT pulled his way up inside the winner then steadied in tight on the first turn, came off the rail and dueled outside that rival to the stretch, could not match strides in the final furlong but was clearly second best. PACIFIC COLONY saved ground chasing the leaders, moved up into the stretch, came out a bit in deep stretch and gained the show. DOG DAYS saved ground stalking the pace, came out a bit into the stretch and lacked the needed rally. SPAINBIRD (IRE) allowed to settle outside a rival then a bit off the rail, found the inside in the stretch and improved position. SOLAR WAY pulled his way along to stalk the pace a bit off the rail, went between horses on the second turn and three deep into the stretch and lacked a rally. SEQUOIAN unhurried outside early, moved up some leaving the backstretch, went four wide on the second turn and was not a threat. EXCELLENTCHARACTER steadied after the start, angled in and saved ground, came out into the stretch and failed to menace. PROJECT HOPE off a bit slowly, pulled his way along to stalk outside a rival, went three deep on the second turn, steadied while weakening leaving that bend and dropped back. SILENT BLUFF allowed to settle outside, came a bit wide into the stretch and was not a factor.
