Footnotes

RED WARRIOR off a bit slowly, went up four wide on the first turn, dueled three deep on the backstretch and into the second turn, battled outside the runner-up leaving that bend and in the stretch and gamely kicked clear late under left handed urging. EXCEEDING prompted the pace inside, fought back in the stretch but could not match the winner late. WILDLY EXCESSIVE pulled early, stalked off the rail, split horses into the second turn, continued outside on that bend and three deep into the stretch and just held third. TIZBUD bobbled in a bit of a slow start, went between horses to vie for the lead, dropped back toward the inside on the second turn, then was coming back at the show horse late. POLITICAL RHETORIC prompted the pace three deep then stalked between horses, went four wide into the second turn and weakened. LOGICIAN three deep into the first turn, chased outside, went five wide into the second turn and also weakened. DECIMATE saved ground chasing the pace, remained inside and had no response in the lane.
