Footnotes

CHIPS ARE DOWN dueled four wide on the backstretch and three deep on the turn and into the stretch, drifted inward in the drive but pulled clear under left handed urging. CAVALRY CHARGE dueled three deep between foes on the backstretch, battled between horses on the turn and into the stretch, also drifted inward in upper stretch and was not a match for the winner. GOLDEN SPEAR had good early speed and dueled inside, fell back a bit into the stretch, steadied when crowded in upper stretch, came out in midstretch and was edged for second. SAINT CALI off a bit slowly, settled off the rail then moved up between horses on the backstretch, angled to the inside on the turn, continued inside and put in a late bid at a minor award. DONNYBROOK PRIDE settled wide between horses, continued outside on the turn and four wide into the stretch and also put in a late bid at a minor award but was not a threat. SALTY HUMOR off a bit awkwardly, settled just off the inside, angled in some on the turn and did not rally. TAKE A CHANCE chased a bit off the rail, angled in and dropped back on the backstretch, continued just off the inside and failed to menace. HUNTLEY'S CREEK chased outside then off the rail, angled in some on the turn and weakened. ALLRIGHT dueled between horses, dropped back into the turn, came out into the stretch and also weakened. PROP FIVE went up inside on the backstretch then steadied in tight, continued inside on the turn and was not a threat. SURE THING EVA wide early, chased outside and four wide into the turn, came three deep into the stretch and was not a factor. Following a claim of foul by the rider of GOLDEN SPEAR against CAVALRY CHARGE, the latter was disqualified and placed third for interference in upper stretch.
