Footnotes

TIZ FLIRTATIOUS broke slowly, came off the rail on the backstretch, went outside a rival on the turn, swung four wide into the stretch and rallied under strong handling and a late left handed crack of the whip to get up on the line. TEACHER TEACHER chased outside then off the rail on the turn, came four wide into the stretch, bid three deep and took the lead past the eighth pole, inched away and was caught late. SASSY SUANCES stalked off the inside, bid three wide into the stretch, took a short advantage between horses in midstretch and held third. CEE'S THE YEAR steadied between foes after the start to drop back off the rail, angled in leaving the backstretch, came out into the stretch and put in a late bid at a minor award. WARREN'S BOOGIE dropped back between horses then chased a bit off the rail, angled out into the stretch and lacked the needed rally. BEE EFF EFF bobbled at the start, went up inside to stalk the pace, came out for room into the stretch, was in a bit close off heels in upper stretch and could not offer the necessary late kick. OHHHH A WISE GUY had good early speed and dueled inside, fought back into the stretch and until just past midstretch, then weakened. SWISS GEM chased a bit off the rail then inside into the turn, came out into the stretch and did not rally. SONG BY WEST had speed between horses then dueled outside a rival, continued between foes into the stretch and weakened.
