ACCLAMATION steadied in a bit tight passing the eighth pole the first time, stalked outside a rival then just off the rail, bid alongside the pacesetter on the second turn, took the lead into the stretch, inched away in midstretch, drifted out and held on gamely under some urging with the whip turned down and good handling. CHAMP PEGASUS three deep into the clubhouse turn, stalked outside a rival, came three wide into the stretch, loomed a threat behind the winner in midstretch and continued willingly but could not catch that one. IMPONENTE PURSE (BRZ) between foes early, stalked inside then between horses again into and on the second turn, came out into the stretch, was four wide in deep stretch and bested the rest. ASHTAR (CHI) in tight passing the furlong marker the first time, saved ground stalking the pace, came out into the stretch and weakened. DYNAMIC HOST angled in early and chased inside, split rivals in deep stretch and lacked the needed rally. MAKE MUSIC FOR ME tugged his way along four wide on the hill and five wide on the dirt crossing, took the lead and angled inward in midstretch the first time, set the pace a bit off the rail then inside, fought back leaving the second turn and into the stretch and weakened in the final furlong. BUENOS DIAS (IRE) angled in and chased outside a rival, went three deep on the second turn and four wide into the stretch and also weakened.
