EXCLAMATION (GB) angled in and dueled three deep, inched away nearing the turn, responded when challenged midway on the bend, inched away again in the stretch and held on gamely under urging. FORTUNATE APPEAL stalked off the rail, went up three deep into the turn, bid alongside the winner, had that one slip away in the stretch then was coming back on late. DEE DEE'S LEGACY settled off the rail, came out on the turn and six wide into the stretch and gained the show. SKIPPY DUE a bit slow to begin, moved up inside on the backstretch, steadied when bumped between foes into and midway on the

turn, came out four wide into the stretch and lacked the needed rally. CARBON HOOFPRIINT (GB) dueled between horses then stalked between foes, also steadied when bumped between rivals into and midway on the turn to fall back, split horses a quarter mile out, found the rail into the stretch and lacked the needed response. COLOURSOFTHGLEEN (IRE) chased between rivals, also steadied when bumped between foes into and midway on the turn, came four wide into the stretch and could not offer the necessary response. MIND THE MINISTER chased outside, went up five wide on the turn and into the stretch and did not rally. RAINGEAR settled off the rail then outside, came out five wide into the stretch and was not a threat. U. C. MERCED TWO stalked off the rail then outside, went up four wide on the turn, angled in some leaving the turn and weakened. LEANDROS (FR) chased off the inside, split horses on the turn, came out four wide into the stretch and lacked the needed response. ROMAN GUITAR had good early speed and dueled inside, stalked along the rail into the turn, dropped back leaving the turn and into the stretch, gave way and was eased in the final furlong.
