Footnotes

MISS VALID MOMENT settled outside, moved up four and three wide on the turn, then wore down OBJECTOFTHEWORD late under some urging. OBJECTOFTHEWORD dueled three deep on the backstretch and outside a rival on the turn, got clear leaving the bend, angled in and could not hold off the winner. FLYING CAROLYN broke outward, went up to prompt the pace between rivals, remained between foes on the turn, angled in through the stretch and held third. BRASSY ANNIE, sent inside on the backstretch, came out a bit to split rivals nearing the stretch but lacked the needed late response. AVENIDA LA CRESTA, squeezed at the start, settled outside, went four wide on the turn and into the stretch and lacked the necessary rally. HERESTHATRAINyday dueled four wide on the backstretch, dropped back a bit on the turn and weakened. SMART WIFE stumbled at the start, settled well off the rail and did not rally. AMBERROSA, bumped at the start, also raced off the rail and weakened. NEXT ISSUE, bumped and squeezed at the start, also raced off the inside, swung out into the stretch and did not rally. MISS KILKEE was outrun off the inside and was not a threat. WHERE'S BOB settled a bit off the rail and also failed to menace. FLORES WILD CAT was sent inside to vie for the lead to the middle of the turn and had little left.
