Footnotes

MASH ONE (CHI) forced the early pace inside, dropped back, let the two leaders slip away leaving the backstretch, rallied along the rail in the stretch to gain the lead just past the eighth pole and pulled clear under urging. LAZY LODER (ARG) held a slim lead outside the winner early, inched away a bit off the rail, dueled inside DOCKSIDER, shook off that one into the stretch, fought back outside the winner in midstretch but could not match that one while best of the rest. BONAPARTISTE (FR) saved ground in a good striking position, came outside the winner leaving the final turn and three deep into the stretch and just held third. SAYARSHAN (FR) settled toward the inside unhurried, came out on the final turn and again into the stretch and just missed third., MAJORIEN (GB) stalked the pace outside BONAPARTISTE, continued a bit off the rail on the final turn and three deep into the stretch and lacked the needed response. DOCKSIDER pulled his way along to stalk the early pace, bid outside LAZY LODER on the backstretch and last turn, then drifted inward and weakened in the final furlong.
