BRISQUETTE forced the pace inside on the backstretch, was taken out and battled outside a rival on the turn, took a short lead on the bend, inched clear in the stretch and held under urging. SMART START chased a bit off the rail, came out into the stretch, could not catch the winner but continued willingly to hold the place. BAFFERTA sped to the early lead and dueled outside the winner, inched away between calls and angled in early on the turn, fought back inside when headed but could not match the top pair while best of the rest. STORM KISU hopped at the start to be off a bit slowly, settled outside a rival chasing the leaders and lacked the needed rally. MEADOW PEACE saved ground off the pace, came a bit off the rail into the stretch and also could not offer the necessary response. GIVE PRAISE was in a good position stalking outside on the backstretch, dropped back three deep on the turn, angled in and weakened.
