Footnotes

BIG MACHER pressed the pace on the outside down the backstretch and into the turn, took a short lead at the quarter pole and drew clear through the stretch under urging. MARINO MIZER sped to the early lead, set the pace a bit off the rail down the backstretch, battled inside around the turn, could not keep pace in the stretch, drifted out in the final furlong but held the place. SECOND PROPOSAL chased on the inside down the backstretch, saved ground around the turn, rallied on the rail through the final furlong and was edged for the place on the wire. MI HIJO was outrun down the backstretch and around the turn, swung widest in the stretch, improved his position in the final furlong and was edged for the show on the wire. STREET CHOIR chased the pace three wide into the turn, came into the stretch four deep and lacked the needed rally in the final furlong. BROKER BRETT chased the pace a bit off the rail down the backstretch, came into the lane three wide and weakened through the lane. MARKET PORTFOLIO stalked the pace on the inside down the backstretch, saved ground around the turn and weakened on the rail through the lane. ANYTIME bobbled at the start, chased between horses into the turn, fell back around the turn and weakened in the stretch drive.
