QUEEN OF WILSHIRE sped to the early lead, set the pace inside, inched away on the second turn and held on gamely under a strong hand ride. NASHOBA (IRE) settled outside a rival early, continued outside on the backstretch and three deep on the second turn, angled in leaving that bend, came out in the stretch, could not catch the winner but gamely took second. VENCERA (FR) settled outside a rival then toward the inside, found the rail on the second turn, bid inside in the stretch and just missed the place. JEWELED PIRATE came off the inside on the first turn, went three deep into the second turn, continued between horses on that bend, came out in the stretch and lacked the needed late kick. CRYSTAL HOUSE (CHI) broke slowly, trailed off the rail, went outside rivals on the second turn and five wide into the stretch and improved position. THEWHOLEBAG floated wide nearing the first turn, angled in on that bend and saved ground, was between horses into the second turn then was shuffled a bit midway on that bend, continued inside nearing the stretch and also lacked the necessary response. SISSI SONG (FR) saved ground, moved up inside into and on the second turn, came out into the stretch to loom a threat but weakened. NOTABLE CAREER forced the early pace outside the winner then stalked that one off the rail, came three deep into the stretch and also weakened. PRINCESS TI (BRZ) rank early, drifted out into the first turn, stalked the pace off the rail, drifted wide again into the stretch and gave way.
