**Footnotes**

PLEASANTLY PERFECT settled a bit off the rail, was briefly in a bit tight off heels leaving the first turn, came out on the backstretch and moved up five wide, continued off the rail on the second turn and four wide into the stretch, rallied to the front between horses nearing the sixteenth pole and gamely prevailed under urging. FLEETSTREET DANCER chased three deep on the first turn, moved up six wide on the backstretch, remained outside on the second turn and five wide into the stretch and closed willingly. STAR CROSS (ARG) between foes early, prompted the pace outside a rival then stalked between foes, dropped back leaving the backstretch, lugged out some into the stretch, angled out behind rivals in midstretch and came back on for third. JOEY FRANCO pulled his way between horses and was in a bit tight leaving the first turn, bid three deep leaving the backstretch and outside a rival into the stretch, put a head in front nearing midstretch but weakened late. TASTE OF PARADISE took the early lead and angled in, set a pressured pace a bit off the rail, fought back into the stretch, had the rider lose the whip in midstretch and weakened. REBA'S GOLD saved ground stalking the pace and weakened in the stretch. GREY MEMO settled off the rail without early speed, came out into the stretch and did not rally. TOCCTET pulled his way along outside stalking the early pace, tugged his way up three deep to force the pace on the backstretch, continued between foes into and on the second turn, dropped back into the stretch and had little left.
