Footnotes

KAFWAIN pulled early, chased inside, came out on the second turn and four wide into the stretch, drifted inward in the drive, took a short lead in midstretch and gamely prevailed under urging. BULL MARKET went up inside to duel for the lead, inched away on the backstretch, fought back when headed in the stretch and continued gamely to the wire. LISTEN INDY stalked the pace outside a rival, bid three deep into the stretch and went willingly to the end. ROYAL SIPHON bobbled slightly at the start, dueled outside the runner-up, stalked that one off the rail on the backstretch and second turn, drifted inward in the drive and weakened. MR. TECHNIQUE was in a good position stalking the pace inside, came out into the stretch and also weakened. MANHATTAN EXPRESS unhurried toward the inside early, came out on the backstretch, went three deep into the second turn and lacked a further response. OBERWALD pulled outside the winner early, chased outside that one on the backstretch, dropped back and angled in on the second turn and gave way.
