Footnotes

ALBERT G stalked between horses on the backstretch and inside on the turn, came out in midstretch and rallied under urging to get up late. TOTAL LIMIT had speed five wide then inched away and angled in on the backstretch, dueled inside on the turn, inched away again in the stretch and held on well but was caught late. POHAVE stalked the pace between horses on the backstretch and turn, continued outside a rival into the stretch and held third. ALERT chased outside on the backstretch, moved up menacingly four wide on the turn and three deep into the stretch but weakened in the final furlong. KIRSCHWASSER allowed to settle outside on the backstretch and four wide into the turn, angled in off the rail on the bend and lacked the needed late kick. IMPERIAL KING unhurried a bit off the rail early, angled in for the turn and lacked the needed response. ROCK THE STONE chased outside on the backstretch and three deep nearing the turn, angled in on the bend and also lacked the necessary rally. IDE RATHER off a bit slowly, saved ground off the pace, came out into the stretch and failed to menace. VALUE PLAY broke slowly, drifted well off the rail early, came five wide into the stretch and was outrun. A GRADE ABOVE close up between horses then outside pressing the pace, dropped back on the turn and weakened. WHEATER was in a good position chasing off the rail on the backstretch, came four wide into the stretch and also weakened. STATUS sent inside to chase the leaders, also dropped back on the turn and gave way.
