WARREN'S SUGARBUZZ saved ground chasing the pace, moved up inside leaving the turn, came out in midstretch and wore down the runner-up late under urging. ECONOMY OF MOTION sped to the early lead, set the pace along the inside, held on well but was worn down in the late stages. DELTA squeezed a bit at the start, settled off the rail, went outside on the turn and three deep into the stretch and finished well. JESSE'S GIACOMO chased three deep then outside a rival on the turn, came out into the stretch, angled to the inside past midstretch and lacked the needed rally. AWE' SOME KITTEN stalked between horses then a bit off the rail into and on the turn and could not offer the necessary response. GLORYANDPRAYER bobbled at the start, chased between foes then a bit off the rail, angled to the inside on the turn and lacked a response in the stretch. BLACK OAK stalked three deep then outside a rival on the turn and into the stretch and weakened. SWEET SATURDAY had speed between foes then stalked the pace, dropped back between foes on the turn and gave way. SNACKABLE broke in a bit, was between horses early, dropped back off the rail, gave way, was eased leaving the turn and in the stretch.
