A LIL EXCESS dueled outside the runner-up on the backstretch, stalked that one on the turn, then gradually wore down that rival in deep stretch under urging. FASHION CONTROL went up inside to duel on a short lead inside the winner on the backstretch, inched away on the turn and held on well but could not match strides late. SABULOUS settled off the rail, inched forward toward the inside on the turn, split horses into the stretch and picked up the show while the rider lost the whip late. NORI JEANNINE unhurried off the inside early, angled in some on the turn and improved position inside. VAGABONDIA chased outside a rival on the backstretch and turn, came three deep into the stretch and weakened. BARDELLA broke out and slowly, stalked the pace along the inside, dropped back into the stretch and gave way, then was eased up late. FABULOUS BABY settled outside a rival early, dropped far back and gave way readily. JOY'S NOTEBOOK also settled off the rail, angled in some on the turn, dropped back, then was pulled up in midstretch but walked off.
