Footnotes

ELUSIVE SCHEMES stalked the pace outside a rival, bid alongside the pacesetter on the second turn, took the lead into the stretch, inched away under urging while drifting out a bit and won clear. MORGANOUSKA sped to the early lead, set the pace inside, dueled along the rail on the second turn, fought back into the stretch and until midstretch, could not match the winner in the final furlong but held the place. LUV DRAGON three deep into the first turn,

stalked outside a rival then off the rail on the second turn, came out into the stretch and just held the show. MR. SATURDAYNIGHT close up stalking the pace inside, came a bit off the rail in the stretch and was edged for third. NORTH FORK chased between horses or outside a rival, came out into the stretch and weakened. EXUMA chased inside then a bit off the rail, split horses into the second turn, continued inside on that bend and did not rally. NITRO ACTIVE settled outside chasing the pace, came three deep into the stretch and could not summon the necessary response. JOB BOSS four wide into the first turn, settled outside or off the rail, came out a bit into the stretch and was not a threat. ADVICE pulled his way along and angled in early, chased just off the rail then inside, steadied in tight into the second turn and was not a threat. BOULDER CREEK bobbed slightly at the start, chased between horses then a bit off the rail, came out on the second turn and into the stretch, lacked a further response, was unsaddled at the clubhouse turn and vanned off. EASY ON THE EYE (AUS) three deep into the first turn, angled in and settled just off the rail to the stretch and failed to menace.
