Footnotes

KEY REVERSAL had good early speed and dueled inside, inched away on the turn and drew clear in the stretch under some urging and strong handling. STAR OF AMERICA had speed off the inside then angled in and prompted the pace three deep, stalked just off the rail on the turn and was clearly second best. UNUSUAL MYSTERY stalked three deep then between foes on the backstretch, split horses on the turn, angled to the inside approaching the stretch and bested the others. HARLAN'S WEEKEND chased outside then five wide into the turn, continued outside, split horses three deep into the stretch and lacked a rally. MIDNIGHT RAVEN a bit slow to begin, settled outside, went six wide into the turn and four wide into the stretch and could not offer the necessary response. HE'S A SURE CALL pulled his way along between horses to stalk the pace, went four wide leaving the backstretch, angled in between foes on the turn, found the rail in the stretch and weakened. INGORDO broke outward, was between horses early then chased off the rail, angled in some for the turn and was not a threat. WILD FOR LADIES close up stalking the pace between horses, continued a bit off the rail on the turn and weakened. TAYLOR MARINI broke inward, chased off the rail, came a bit wide into the stretch and had little left for the drive. DREAM SQUAD squeezed at the start, settled off the inside throughout and was not a factor. EL CUARENTA angled in and dueled between horses, dropped back and angled in on the turn, gave way and was eased in the final furlong. TONY'S ON HIS WAY broke inward and slowly, settled off the rail then angled in on the backstretch, was through early and eased in the stretch. SKY DRIVER close up stalking the pace inside, steadied while dropping back on the turn, came out into the stretch and also gave way readily and was eased in the drive.
