MERIT MAN had good early speed and dueled three deep, forced the pace outside the runner-up leaving the turn, took the lead nearing the stretch, inched away approaching midstretch and drew clear under urging. SOUTH FLOYD also flashed good early speed and dueled inside, fought back on the turn, could not match the winner in the stretch but was clearly second best. NO RACHMONES chased off the rail, came three deep into the stretch and outfinished rivals for the show. ZEEWAT broke a bit slowly, settled inside then just off the rail on the backstretch, angled to the fence on the turn, continued inside through the stretch and was edged for third. SCHERER MAGIC tugged his way along to duel between horses and was momentarily in a bit tight a half mile out, fell back some and stalked just off the rail leaving the turn, was between foes through the final furlong and weakened.
