Footnotes

AVARE sped to the early lead, dueled inside on the backstretch and second turn, inched away in upper stretch, kicked clear and proved best under some urging. TIZ A MINISTER settled three deep then outside a rival, lacked room off heels in upper stretch, swung out and rallied willingly outside to get up for second late. IRISH SURF came off the rail on the first turn, stalked outside a rival then between foes leaving the backstretch and on the second turn, continued just off the rail past midstretch and was edged for the place. BACARDI CAT RUN pulled outside rivals then angled in on the first turn, stalked inside to the stretch and could not summon the necessary late kick. MONTEREY TALE chased between horses, went three deep between foes on the second turn and into the stretch, was in a bit tight off heels past midstretch and lacked the needed rally. BORNATTHETRACK stalked three deep, came four wide into the stretch and could not summon the necessary late response. MAXX THE GIANT stalked early then bid alongside the winner and dueled for the lead, briefly put a head in front on the second turn, fought back leaving that turn and weakened in the final furlong. GREELEY AWESOME saved ground chasing the pace, lacked room along the rail from midstretch to deep stretch and could not offer the needed rally. LAWYER GABE chased three deep then four wide on the second turn, came five wide into the stretch and also lacked a rally. ROB'S PAL angled in and chased outside a rival then between horses

on the second turn, was boxed in off heels through the final furlong. CHRISTOPHER STREET broke a bit slowly, angled in and saved ground to no avail. JUST IRISH away a bit awkwardly, settled off the rail then outside into and on the second turn, came three deep into the stretch and was not a threat.
