Footnotes

MORELL'S LOVE, dueled four wide early and three deep on the backstretch, put a head in front outside LOTTA SWING leaving the turn, inched clear, then held on gamely under urging. THE WIND MORIA, close up between foes early, took back off the rail, ranged up three deep into the stretch, bid outside the winner and continued gamely but could not get by. HEIDIJIM N' GRANT, between horses early, angled in, saved ground thereafter and picked up the show. MARQUEE'S PRIZED forced the early pace between rivals, dropped back some, was outside a foe on the turn and weakened. ENTER SMILING was well placed four wide and also weakened. BEEN TO THE DESERT, saved ground, moved up on the turn, came out a bit for the stretch and lacked a further response. LOTTA SWING, angled in and dueled for command to the stretch, then weakened. QUEEN GEN was a bit crowded after the start, settled off the rail, briefly went between horses into the turn, then gave way.
