TRICK Z bumped early, went between foes and dueled outside a rival on the backstretch, kicked clear on the turn and proved best under steady handling. CIRCLE LATOUR allowed to settle outside on the backstretch and alongside a rival on the turn, came out into the stretch and picked up the place. EVENING WALK stalked the pace off the rail on the backstretch and turn, found the fence in the stretch and held third. TOASTIE'S CROWN wide early, raced close up stalking the pace outside on the backstretch and three deep on the turn and lacked the needed late response. RALSY squeezed back at the start, went between horses on the backstretch, angled in some on the turn and did not rally. DENAMAX settled off the rail early then between foes on the backstretch, was a bit crowded into the turn and also lacked a rally. CAN CAN ROYALTY unhurried off the rail on the backstretch and turn, came wide into the stretch and failed to menace. BLUE EYED K. C. saved ground off the early pace, came out into the stretch and was not a threat. REALLY CAN drifted out and bumped the winner early, angled in and dueled inside on the backstretch, dropped back on the turn and weakened.
