Footnotes

FREEDOM CREST stalked the early pace off the rail, moved up on the backstretch and bid between horses then outside SKIMMING on the second turn, took a short lead under urging in midstretch and inched away late. SKIMMING sped to the early lead, set the pace inside, responded when challenged, fought back inside the winner through a long drive but could not quite match that one late. TIZNOW chased outside the winner, ranged up three deep leaving the backstretch and into the second turn, dropped back some on that bend, came under urging a quarter mile out and was slowly gaining late. DIG FOR IT allowed to settle outside a rival to the stretch, drifted inward in the drive and lacked the needed rally. DIXIE DOT COM came off the inside leaving the first turn and chased the pace, went four wide into the stretch and lacked a further response. TRIBUNAL off a bit slowly, angled in and saved ground off the pace, came out a bit in the stretch and failed to menace.
