UNCLE DENNY dueled three deep on the backstretch and turn, put a head in front in upper stretch and gamely prevailed under urging. SHANGHAI JOE vied for command between horses, gained a slim advantage leaving the turn, fought back between foes in midstretch, could not quite match the winner late but held second. TERRITORIAL saved ground stalking the pace, came out leaving the turn and four wide into the stretch and just missed the place. LORD MACHO angled in and dueled inside, fought back leaving the turn and into the stretch but weakened in the final furlong. AH SALUTE dropped back off the rail on the backstretch, angled in some on the turn, came out in the stretch and passed a pair of tiring rivals. REGAL PAN chased between foes then off the rail, angled to the inside on the turn and weakened. CAPERS TOWN chased between horses then three deep on the backstretch, continued outside on the turn, came a bit wide into the stretch and had little left.
