Footnotes

MISS BECCA hopped slightly at the start, chased between horses then outside a rival, came three deep into the stretch, gained the advantage alongside the pacesetter just past the eight pole and drew off under a steady hand ride. BENSANNA sped to the early lead, angled in and set the pace inside, battled

briefly inside the winner in midstretch and just held second. LEGGYLANGLEYLASSIE chased between foes then a bit off the rail, steadied alongside the riderless horse into the turn, split foes on the bend, came four wide into the stretch and just missed the place. SMOKEY LAKE steadied at the start, settled outside then off the rail, went four wide on the turn and five wide into the stretch and bested the others. JADE'S SONG settled between horses then outside, came four wide into the stretch and did not rally. WHEATY'S WELL stalked a bit off the rail on the backstretch and turn, came out into the stretch and weakened. ROYAL PEARL between horses early, angled in on the backstretch, steadied when crowded by the riderless horse into the turn and weakened. PRIDE OF GOLD wide early, stalked outside then went three deep into the turn, continued off the rail on the bend and also weakened. CLEAR THE SET went up inside then steadied in tight midway on the backstretch, came a bit off the rail and did not rally. SINGLE IN MAY angled in and stalked just off the inside on the backstretch and turn, dropped back into the stretch and weakened. SATCHMO'S MUSE a bit slow to begin, pulled some and had the saddle slip along the inside on the backstretch, dropped back and was eased in the final furlong. FOREVER ISMAY stumbled badly at the start and lost the rider. The stewards conducted an inquiry into the start before ruling FOREVER ISMAY was the cause of her own trouble.
