VACA CITY FLYER chased outside then off the rail on the turn, came four wide into the stretch, bid three deep in midstretch and gamely prevailed under urging. ETCH bobbled a bit at the start, dueled between foes then outside a rival, gained a short lead in upper stretch, fought back inside through the final furlong and continued gamely to the wire. MEMOGRAM had good early speed outside then stalked off the rail, bid three deep into the stretch and between foes through the final furlong and went on willingly to the end. SMART THOUGHT saved ground off the pace, went around a rival leaving the second turn, came out into the stretch, angled back in and finished with interest. ABBY'S NOT NORMAL unhurried inside then a bit off the rail, angled out into the stretch and found her best stride late. HIGHLY ARROGANT chased between horses then outside on the turn and three deep into the stretch and did not rally. MADAM GENERAL between foes early, chased outside on the backstretch and turn, came four wide into the stretch and lacked the needed response. FUTURE THOUGHT chased a bit off the rail then inside into and on the turn, came out in the stretch and was not a threat. GENERAL EXPRESSION angled in and dueled inside, fought back on the turn but weakened in the stretch.
