STONESIDE (IRE) pulled and came in a bit early, stalked outside a rival, bid alongside the pacesetter on the backstretch and second turn, took the lead into the stretch, inched away and drifted in under left handed urging in midstretch, drifted out from the whip late and held. WINSOME CHARM tugged between foes then stalked inside, split rivals in midstretch, waited off the heels of the winner and angled in just past the eighth pole, came out nearing the sixteenth marker and finished well to just miss. FIRE BREAK pulled early and angled in on the first turn, stalked inside, came out leaving the second turn and into the stretch and bested the others. THEY CALL HIM EL in a bit tight between foes early, angled in and chased outside a rival, came out leaving the second turn and four wide into the stretch and lacked the needed rally. CALIFORNIA SOLDIER sped to the early lead, set the pace inside then dueled along the rail, fought back into the stretch and weakened in the final furlong. MAKER (ARG) three deep into the first turn, chased outside a rival, came out into the stretch and also weakened.
