ALL STAR HEART angled in on the first turn and chased inside, slipped through along the fence into the stretch, bid inside, gained the advantage past midstretch and inched away under urging. VICTORYASECRET took the early lead outside then angled in and pulled on the advantage along the rail, fought back on the second turn, came off the rail into the stretch, battled between foes in midstretch and until deep stretch and held second. WASHINGTON BRIDGE pulled her way along inside then stalked a bit off the rail, bid alongside the runner-up on the backstretch then had that one inch away a half mile out, bid again on the second turn, was fanned out a bit into the stretch, battled three deep in the final furlong and edged rivals for the show. WHISPER LOUISE (IRE) angled in and stalked the pace inside, moved up along the fence in the stretch and was outfinished. ANDINA (IRE) saved ground chasing the pace, went around a rival into the stretch, came out some in the drive and could not offer the necessary late kick. WARREN'S JITTERBUG broke a bit slowly, settled just off the inside, went three deep leaving the second turn and did not rally. NO KA OI stalked outside a rival, fell back between foes leaving the second turn and weakened.
