MELANISTIC had speed three deep then dueled outside a rival, inched away on the turn and drew off in the stretch under urging then steady handling late. TIP YOUR HAT stumbled at the start and dropped back off the rail, advanced outside leaving the turn and three deep into the stretch and gained the place. WARREN'S MORGAN stalked a bit off the rail then outside a rival, went three deep leaving the turn and into the stretch and bested the others. HEART OF A MADAM close up stalking the pace inside, was in a bit tight off heels into the turn, continued along the rail on the bend and in the stretch and weakened. REAL DREAM chased inside, came out leaving the turn, went between foes into the stretch and lacked the needed rally. WARREN'S SAMANTHA broke out and bobbed some, settled outside then alongside a rival, continued off the rail leaving the turn and lacked a response in the stretch. SWEET JUJU had speed between foes then angled in and dueled inside the winner, stalked along the rail on the turn and weakened in the stretch.
