Footnotes

NASHOBA (IRE) pulled early, settled outside a rival, went three deep on the second turn and five wide into the stretch and rallied gamely under left handed urging to get up late. MODESTLY prompted the pace outside DOZEY DOATS, took a short lead between rivals into the second turn, inched away in deep stretch but could not hold off the winner. NO INTEGRITY, four wide early, settled outside a rival, split horses on the second turn, came four wide into the stretch, drifted out a bit in deep stretch but gained the show. MULATA FITZ (ARG) bobbed at the start, settled off the rail, split rivals into the second turn, was in a bit tight behind the winner past midstretch and had a mild late bid. WILD CLASSY LADY, steadied early, came off the rail on the backstretch, bid three deep into and on the second turn, battled outside the runner-up in the stretch and weakened late. FLYING CAROUSEL saved ground in a good position, came out a bit and waited off heels briefly into the stretch, then had a mild bid when clear. TORRENTINA came off the inside on the first turn, went three deep into the second turn and did not rally. EXACT TIME, angled in early and saved ground to no avail. DOZEY DOATS angled in on a short early lead, dueled inside until nearing the stretch, then weakened. A claim of foul by the rider of MULATA FITZ against the winner for alleged interference in the stretch was not allowed by the stewards, who ruled NO INTEGRITY was the main cause of the trouble.
