TAHITIAN RAIN stalked the pace off the rail on the backstretch and turn, bid alongside the leader into the stretch, gained a short lead in upper stretch and pulled clear under urging. LIFE ESTATE hopped in a bit of an awkward start, sped between horses early, set the pace inside, could not match the winner in the final furlong but held second. SILVER REVIEW settled between horses early then moved up outside leaving the backstretch, came three deep into the stretch and picked up the show. CHI CHI NETTE was in a good position stalking along the inside to the stretch and lacked the needed response. MISTY ECHO between horses early, chased a bit off the rail, angled in leaving the turn and also lacked the necessary rally. CARA'S LAST CHANCE chased between horses on the backstretch, angled in on the turn and could not summon the needed rally. RANSOM SONG wide between horses early, chased

outside, went four wide on the turn and was not a threat. HELLO GRAYCIE squeezed a bit at the start, settled off the rail, split foes into the turn and failed to menace. AMANDA QUICK dropped back while wide on the backstretch and into the turn, angled in some on the bend and was outrun. ASIAN NATIVE was in a good position stalking the leader three deep then off the rail into and on the turn and weakened. MISS FATIH broke in a bit, settled off the rail then angled in and saved ground but was outrun. IMALEGACY broke outward and bobbed at the start, pulled his way between horses on the backstretch, dropped back off the rail and gave way.
