HOME SWEET ASPEN sped to the early lead, set a pressured pace a bit off the rail then inside, inched away on the turn and kicked clear in the final furlong under urging. MILDLY OFFENSIVE went up alongside the winner to press the pace, stalked a bit off the rail on the turn and in the stretch and was clearly second best. MADERA CASTANA (CHI) dropped back between horses early, chased off the rail, came out some in the stretch and bested the others. CHURCH CAMP was in a good position stalking the pace inside throughout and weakened in the final furlong. SALTY SARAH turned her head, brushed the side of the gate and broke slowly, tugged her way along three deep on the backstretch, stalked three wide to the stretch and also weakened. CHALULA ONE chased off the rail then between horses, angled in some in the stretch and lacked a further response.
