Footnotes

FAST BULLET had speed between foes then angled in and dueled inside, inched away in the stretch and drew clear under urging. GLOBAL DOMINATION went up five wide between foes to stalk the pace, continued between rivals on the turn, came three deep into the stretch and was clearly second best. ABSOLUTCAT between horses early, stalked inside, was shuffled back midway on the turn, came out in midstretch and edged a rival late for third. STORMBERG stalked a bit off the rail then between horses, angled in for the stretch, was in a bit tight off heels in midstretch and weakened. SWEET THUNDER stalked four wide between horses, was in tight a half mile out, split horses leaving the turn, came three deep into the stretch and lacked the needed response. STONEWALL JACKSON off a bit slowly, settled inside then off the rail, came out on the turn and into the stretch and improved position. FATHER PABST had speed outside then dueled alongside the winner to the stretch and weakened. APPLY stalked six wide on the backstretch and four wide on the turn and into the stretch and weakened. IRA THE ESQUIRE between foes early, chased off the rail, came out five wide into the stretch and did not rally. CANDY SWEETHEART chased inside, was shuffled back on the backstretch, came out on the turn and gave way. KNUCKLEBUSTER stalked between horses, was in tight leaving the backstretch, took up sharply and dropped back on the turn and had little left for the stretch.
