Footnotes

GOLD PRESS was close up outside SUPER WAY, bid three deep on the turn, battled outside LEXICON through a stiff drive and gamely prevailed. LEXICON sped to the early lead, set the pace a bit off the rail, dueled inside the winner in the drive and continued gamely to the wire. ROBYNHOOD was close up a bit off the rail early, split rivals into the stretch and outfinished SING BECAUSE for third. SING BECAUSE came off the inside early, went wide leaving the turn and into the stretch and just missed the show. BOTTLE OF RUM broke alertly then dropped back, angled in for the turn, came out for the stretch and improved position. UNCAGED between rivals on the backstretch, angled to the inside for the turn and lacked the needed rally. SWEET DREAMS settled off the inside, came a bit wide into the stretch and lacked the needed response. BLUE INDIGO raced wide and failed to menace. SUPER WAY prompted the pace inside to the stretch and weakened. SAYITWITHASMILE broke awkwardly, angled in and saved ground but was outrun.
