Footnotes

DIXIE UNION was caught a bit wide into the first turn, went up outside on the backstretch to press the pace, bid outside FOREST CAMP in the stretch and gamely wore down that one under steady left handed urging. FOREST CAMP, bumped lightly at the break, quickly sped to the lead inside, came a bit off the rail under a long hold on the backstretch, angled back in on the second turn, fought back when challenged in the stretch but could not quite match the winner late. ANEES, bumped lightly at the start, saved ground unhurried, moved up on the second turn, came out some for the stretch and bested the rest. NEW ADVANTAGE, outside the runner-up early, stalked outside RADIX ALIS on the backstretch, came out some on the second turn and weakened. STAYTON settled off the inside, came a bit wide into the stretch and failed to respond. RADIX ALIS stumbled at the start but recovered and stalked the early pace off the rail, angled to the fence leaving the first turn, saved ground thereafter, gave way readily and was eased.
