DREAM OF SUMMER stalked the pace outside, ranged up three deep into the stretch, gained the advantage outside the pacesetter past the eighth pole and proved best under some urging. DESERT PEARLS quickly sprinted clear, set the pace inside, fought back inside the winner in midstretch but could not match that one late. LADY WILDCAT stalked off the rail on the backstretch, angled in on the turn, came out in upper stretch and bested the others. WILD KANDACE broke in a bit, settled off the inside, angled to the rail on the turn, came out in midstretch and lacked the needed response. BOONESBORO BEACH off a bit slowly, chased inside then a bit off the rail, came out into the stretch and weakened. KELLI LEE allowed to settle off the rail, came a bit wide into the stretch and did not rally.
