CALIFORNIA FLAG stalked off the rail then outside a rival, bid alongside the leader leaving the hill, took a short lead in midstretch and held on gamely under left handed urging. EXCESSIVE PASSION sped to the early lead, set the pace inside, dueled along the fence leaving the hill, fought back through a stiff drive and went gamely to the wire, then returned to a pole past the line on the main track to be unsaddled and was vanned off. AIN'T NO OTHER stalked the pace inside, came out into the stretch and went willingly to the end. LEROY'S DYNAMAUX angled in and stalked the pace inside, came out for room past midstretch, steadied sharply in tight off heels when boxed in a sixteenth out and continued in close to the wire. CAMP VICTORY was in a good position stalking the pace off the rail, came three deep into the stretch and lacked the needed late kick. POSSE POWER broke outward, dropped back off the rail, came out into the stretch and could not offer the necessary response. AL INSTANTE (CHI) hesitated to be away slowly, moved up inside then chased a bit off the rail, continued outside a rival leaving the hill and lacked the needed rally. EL GATO MALO settled outside a rival then a bit off the rail, angled in leaving the hill, came out into the stretch, drifted in some in the drive and lacked a further response. Rail on hill at 14 feet.
