GOT EVEN sped to the early lead, set the pace inside, fought back when headed in midstretch, regained the advantage under left handed urging in deep stretch, bumped with the runner-up in deep stretch and gamely prevailed. JACK O LYN between foes early, stalked outside a rival then just off the rail leaving the turn, put a head in front alongside the winner in midstretch, fought back, bumped with that one late and was outgamed. GO TO THE PULPIT chased four wide then off the rail, angled in outside a rival on the turn, came three deep into the stretch and gained the show late. MUSTACHE CHARLIE had good early speed then stalked inside or a bit off the rail to the stretch and lost the show late. CAPTAIN MAGIC between foes early, settled inside, came out into the stretch and improved position. TROPILUK chased three deep then outside a rival, came five wide into the stretch and lacked a rally. LEVEL UP was a bit slow into stride and drifted in some at the gap, settled inside then just off the rail, swung four wide into the stretch and was not a threat. MY ROYAL KNIGHT stalked between horses then a bit off the rail, continued inside on the turn and into the stretch and weakened. GANNICUS bobbled at the

start, chased between horses then fell back a bit off the rail into the turn and also weakened. WARREN'S MARSHALL chased between rivals then three deep, continued a bit off the rail on the turn, drifted inward in the stretch and had little left for the drive. AT LAST A WILDCAT between foes early, chased outside, came three deep into the stretch and gave way. A claim of foul by the rider of the runner-up against the winner for alleged interference in late stretch was not allowed by the stewards, who ruled both runners contributed to the contact between them.
