MISS WELL MOLDED chased inside then a bit off the rail, took the lead outside a rival nearing the quarter pole, angled in and inched away and drew clear under some urging and steady handling. ALWAYS A CHANCE settled inside then a bit off the rail chasing the pace, came three deep into the stretch and split horses at the wire for the place. LILLY'S PERFECT between horses early, chased outside a rival, came three deep into the stretch and was edged for a minor award. SMARTY CORN stalked a bit off the rail then outside a rival leaving the second turn and into the stretch and lacked the needed late kick. PINK

BLOSSOM sped to the early lead, set the pace along the inside, fought back briefly on the second turn and weakened in the stretch. TANQUERRAY angled in and settled off the pace inside on the first turn and backstretch, came out into the stretch and lacked the needed rally. GITTEL also angled in and chased inside, came out into the stretch and could not offer the necessary response. LOVE TALE (GB) chased outside then three deep leaving the backstretch, angled in alongside a rival nearing the stretch and did not rally. FIESTA EXPRESS unhurried off the inside then outside a rival leaving the backstretch, came out into the stretch and was not a threat. ENGLISH PUDDIN chased between horses or a bit off the rail, continued a bit off the fence on the second turn and weakened. TOWN BELLE four wide into the first turn, settled outside chasing the pace, dropped back three deep into the stretch and gave way.
