Footnotes

FOLLOW WOODY wide early, chased the leader between rivals to the turn, continued outside ARKWRIGHT on the bend, then wore down PERFECT MANDATE late under some urging. PERFECT MANDATE, broke in and was bumped, was sent to the early lead, angled in, set the pace inside and was worn down late. TIMBER BARON bumped at the break, was close up between rivals on the backstretch, continued off the rail on the turn and lacked a further response but got the show. ARKWRIGHT saved ground, moved up inside on the turn, then weakened. LAGARDERE was off a bit slowly, raced wide, came six wide into the stretch and passed tiring rivals. IS IT TRUE MEX between rivals early, angled in leaving the backstretch, saved ground and weakened. STORM AND SILENCE steadied when shut off at the start, raced well off the rail and five wide into the stretch. GUKLDENSTERN was a bit slow to begin, split foes on the turn and failed to menace. HURRICANE'S EYE raced four wide and gave way. ORDAINED POWER between rivals early, was in a bit tight midway on the backstretch, angled in and gave way. DIGNIFLITE saved ground and was outrun.
