Footnotes

CORPORAL GREINER angled in and showed speed outside a rival then between horses, stalked a bit off the rail, bid three deep leaving the second turn and into the stretch, gained command and drew clear under urging. BELL OF THE YEAR saved ground chasing the pace and rallied along the rail late for second. ANDREA'S ANGEL bobbled slightly at the start, went up three deep on the first turn then dueled outside a rival, was between foes again into the stretch and was edged late for the place. SMOKE 'N TRIUMPH angled in and saved ground chasing the pace, came out into the stretch and lacked a rally. BEST IN THE STORM had good early speed and angled in, dueled inside then briefly inched away a bit off the rail leaving the second turn and into the stretch and weakened. SENORITA JAZZY angled in unhurried early, came a bit off the rail on the backstretch, went three deep into the stretch and was not a threat. NOSSENKO bobbled a bit at the start, chased just off the inside or outside a rival, dropped back in the stretch and weakened.
