**Footnotes**

MEA DOMINA angled in and stalked the leader off the rail, bid between horses into and on the second turn, took the lead a quarter mile out and pulled clear in the final furlong under steady handling. PENNY'S FORTUNE pulled a bit early, angled in and stalked inside, waited off heels leaving the second turn, swung three deep for room into the stretch and finished well but could not catch the winner. COSTUME DESIGNER stalked the pace outside a rival, bid three deep into and on the second turn, continued outside the winner to midstretch, then weakened some and just held third. SHAKE OFF saved ground chasing the pace, split horses in midstretch and just missed the show inside. SWEET WIN chased inside then between horses on the second turn and into the stretch and lacked the needed rally. LOVELY RAFAELA chased outside a rival, went three deep on the second turn and four wide into the stretch and could not summon the necessary late response. SAGITTA RA allowed to settle toward the inside, came out leaving the second turn and three deep into the stretch and also lacked the needed late kick. JOHN'S KINDA GIRL off a bit slowly, angled in and saved ground off the pace, came out on the second turn and five wide into the stretch and was not a threat. POTION sped to the early lead, set the pace inside, dueled along the rail on the second turn, dropped back into the stretch and had little left.
